#### PRINCIPLE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the overall planning, management and execution of the Circular Fashion Programme targeting local and international schools, including but not limited to year round educational talks, upcycling workshops, storytime events, and strategic projects depending on the annual direction
- Leads on all the programme management with our school and student network, including outreach and marketing, workshop and talk design, content development, resource writing, pricing and budgeting, goal setting, timeline, activity scheduling, data collection, filing and documentation, impact measurement, and reporting
- Be the main driver of the Redress primary and secondary school curriculum and capacity building initiatives to cater actual school needs on sustainability education, such as research, resource development, teacher training sessions, consultation with the education bodies such as the EDB
- Monitors and maintains the Circular Fashion Education Toolkit, including promotion, annual content review, maintenance with internal and external web developers, and user feedback and analysis
- Together with the wider Circular Fashion Programme team, manages the school delivery within the Get Redressed Month (May 2024) including planning and timeline, outreach and marketing, talk design, activity scheduling and reporting
- As part of the Circular Fashion Programme team, supports the planning and delivery of other key activities including: Takeback Programme, Get Redressed Month, Sort-a-thon and Pop-Up Shops.
- As part of the Redress team, supports the wider activities, e.g. the grand final show of the Redress Design Award.
